How to reach Pollenzo

By Car

From the **A6 Torino-Savona motorway**, exit at Marene, turn right, following the signs for Bra. Once in Bra, follow the signs for Pollenzo. Once arrived in Pollenzo, drive past the roundabout and take the second right onto Via Carlo Alberto, which leads to Piazza Vittorio Emanuele.

From the **A21 Torino-Piacenza motorway**, exit at Asti Est, turn right, following the signs for Alba-Bra, first on the ring road and then on State Road SS231 following first the Alba sign, and then Alba-Bra one. At the traffic lights, continue on the state road and after Cinzano turn left

towards Pollenzo. Drive past the roundabout on provincial road 7, and after a few hundred metres, turn left onto via Amedeo di Savoia until you get to Piazza Vittorio Emanuele.

From Bra

Follow the signs for Alba downhill until the traffic lights, then turn right following the sign for Pollenzo. Once there, drive past the roundabout and take the second right onto Via Carlo Alberto, which leads to Piazza Vittorio Emanuele.

By Train

Direct connections for Bra are available from the railway stations of Torino Porta Nuova (approximately one hour), Alba (approximately 25 minutes) and Asti (approximately 70 minutes). From Bra, city bus no. 2 runs to Pollenzo from the stop opposite the station (approximately every 1½ hours; journey time is approximately 15 minutes).

By Plane

Torino Caselle is the nearest international airport. A shuttle-bus service connects the airport to the main railway station of Torino Porta Nuova. Other convenient airports are **Milan (Linate and Malpensa)**, **Genoa Cristoforo Colombo**, and **Cuneo Levaldigi**. To reach Pollenzo from the airports, please follow the directions provided for car or train journeys.
